The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) through Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) is providing relief in Haiti.

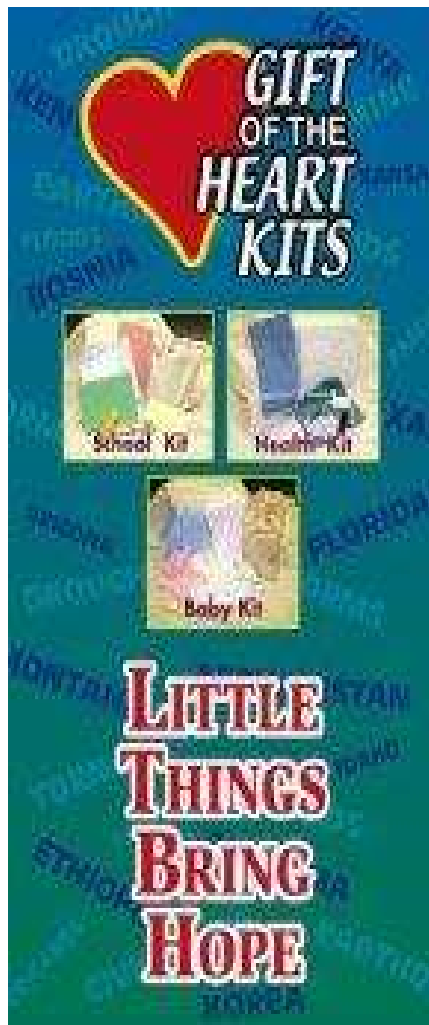
Here's what YOU can do...

GIVE: In disasters the most pressing need is money. You may give to the ongoing need for relief through PDA Account number DR000064. Gifts can be made by phone at 800-872-3283; on line at www.pcusa.org/pda; or by mailing a check to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance PO Box 643700, Pittsburgh, PA 15264-3700. Reference Haiti Efforts and include the designated account number DR 000064 on your check. Gifts by check may be given through VFPC as well—again be sure to reference Haiti Efforts and the PDA account number DR000064.

ACT: Presbyterian Disaster Assistance is shipping hygiene kits to Haiti and to build up warehouse inventory for other disasters. The Mission Committee invites members and friends to purchase items and bring assembled kits to the Fellowship Hall following Worship Services now through Sunday March 7th. Assembling kits is a wonderful hands-on project for individuals, families and groups who want a tangible project to be involved in Haiti relief.

PRESBYTERIAN DISASTER ASSISTANCE

HYGIENE KIT

- 1-hand towel (approximately 16"x28", no fingertip or bath towels)
- 1-washcloth
- 1-wide tooth comb
- 1-nail clipper (no metal files or emery boards)
- 1-bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 1-toothbrush (in original packaging)
- 6- Band-Aids® or other adhesive bandage strips

Please do not add toothpaste to the hygiene kit. Toothpaste which has an extended expiration date will be added to Hygiene kit shipments just prior to shipment.

Seal all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with a zipper closure.
